**Hello, Everyone!** Thank you for entering the September 27-28, 2014 CPE trial hosted by AgileDogs Agility Training. This is your entry confirmation. Your individual entry confirmation will be coming in a separate email. Please be sure to look at it closely and let me know of any errors or move ups.

We are going to do our best to move the trial along efficiently while making sure everyone has a safe and successful run and gets their time in the ring. Walk throughs will be timed at 7 minutes all weekend long. We will be counting on our volunteers (thank you so, so much!) to help make the weekend go smoothly. Please listen to both the general briefing in the morning and the judge's class briefings for ways we can make the trial run more efficiently and for any changes to the schedule.

Any conflicts between our trial and the Stockade USDAA trial will be happily accommodated as long as you inform the gate that you have a conflict. We will make sure you get your run in, don't stress!

In an effort to be more ECO friendly we will not be providing individual bottles of water. Bulk water & sugar free lemonade will be available for environmental reasons for volunteers. Paper Cups will be available but it is suggested that you bring your favorite refillable bottle so you may take your water into the rings while working.

PLEASE NOTE FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR COMPETITORS AND OTHERS WHO MAY BE USING THE SITE THERE IS A STRICT 5MPH SPEED LIMIT AT THE SITE, THOSE GOING OVER THIS WILL BE EXCUSED FROM THE EVENT! This is also a horse show grounds and while there will not be a show going on, there may be some there practicing. PLEASE show them respect.

YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG. IF YOU DO NOT PICK UP YOUR POOP YOU WILL BE EXCUSED. THIS IS A BEAUTIFUL SITE AND WE WANT TO KEEP IT THAT WAY.

Note to those with RV's with generators we request that they must be shut off no later than 10pm. This is to minimize the late night noise impact on our neighbors. (Note there will be one large generator running though-out the night to maintain our food vendor's refrigerator and freezer)

*There will be NO measuring of dogs AFTER the Judges Briefing begins each day – ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT HEIGHT CARD MUST BE MEASURED before the Judges' Briefing in order to show that day – THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS.*

You can move your dog within a class to make sure you have time to concentrate on having a successful run with your 4-footed partner.

If your job for a given class is timer, scribe, assistant scribe, or gate steward, please report to the chief ring steward when the briefing for the class begins, so you can prepare for your job and so the judge can brief you if needed – thanks! If your job is anything not already mentioned, you can report any time before or during the walk through.

During the trial, move-ups in Standard and Jackpot will be taken at the show, and must be submitted to the Show Secretary before the completion of the last class of the day. Thank you for your cooperation.

**The deadline for contacting the secretary with move ups or corrections before the trial is the end of day on Monday, September 22<sup>nd</sup>.** Any changes to entries made after that date will be subject to a \$5 service change fee.

## **DIRECTIONS TO Trial Site**

StockadeAgility is located at 505 Sacandaga Road (Route 147) in Glenville, New York. Our driveway is directly across from Spring Road and has rail fencing on both sides of the drive.

From Route 29 (points north): Turn on Route 147 heading south. Pass through Galway, cross Route 67 and continue on Route 147 toward Scotia. Show is approximately 9 miles from Route 67, on the right.

From Route 67: Take Route 67 west from Ballston Spa / east from Amsterdam, to Route 147 (traffic light, Stewart's, big white church at intersection). Turn south on Route 147 and proceed 9 miles. Grounds are less than one mile (south) past Stewart's on route 147. Look for the blinking traffic light, Beukendaal Firehouse on the right. The Stockade driveway is just before the Beukendaal Firehouse on the right.

From I-90/Route 890 (points east): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 25 or other access) toward Rotterdam. Continue past Schenectady, Campbell and Rice Roads. Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn) 890 becomes Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. The driveway to Stockade is just past the Beukendaal Firehouse on the left.

From I-90/Route 890 (points west): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 26 keep left after toll booths). Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn) 890 becomes Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. The driveway to Stockade is just past the Beukendaal Firehouse on the left.
